Tom Fetherling, President, called the meeting to order at 8:32 am.

Officers in attendance included:

There were 26 Captains present for the Draft. Today the Draft System will be "drawing names from the can".

President Fetherling discussed the new BCA rule change in 8-ball:

Important: There has been a change in the BCA rules in 8-ball: The rule change is as follows – The penalty for any foul on the break has changed from ball in hand in the kitchen to ball in hand. Since we play by BCA rules, this will become effective when play begins 8/18/10. Captains, be sure to inform your teammates of this change.

A vote was taken regarding father and sons playing together. There were 19 FOR and 7 AGAINST. The motion carried.

A vote was taken for rule changes as suggested by Ken O'Hanlon. There were 16 FOR and 5 AGAINST. After a great deal of discussion, Rule #1:

If a team has two A's and only a B, C, or D playing, then the two A's play by themselves. If a team has only two players present, and one of them is an A, only 5 games can be won by the A.

After discussion, it was agreed and decided to have the Opposing Team Captain who would decide who should play alone.

Rule #2 was voted as stated:

If in getting a sub, a C can substitute for a D, since we only have 14 D's. The alternative to this is a B shooting by himself.

Following the vote, the Draft was conducted and teams were selected and recorded by Bill Turechek.

The following teams were short one player due to the lack of players:

Team #1, #3, #7, #10, #15, #25, and #34.

President Fetherling allowed 5 minutes for "swapping of players".

The Draft was completed at 9:30 am and meeting adjourned.

The Captains Day 9-Ball Tournament took place following the draft, race to 3 and call the 9-ball. Results were as follows:
